Class Updates

FSU – We are enjoying watching our tadpoles and caterpillars grow. We have planted lots of seeds and some of these are already impressive! Year 1/2 - Class 1 are working on solving problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in Maths. In English we will be reading and writing instructions. In Class 2 we are writing instructions to make healthy snacks. In Maths we are looking at 2d and 3d shapes.

Year 3/4 - This week we will be investigating symmetry and positioning of shapes in Maths and concluding our English topic of Non Chronological reports.

Year 4/5 – In 4/5 this week, we will be learning space poems for a recital on Friday. In Maths we will be spotting acute, obtuse and reflex angles in our environment and learning how to measure them with a protractor! Why don't you have a go at finding them at home too?

Year 5/6 & 6 - This week we are solving time problems and introducing Algebra in Maths. In Literacy we are continuing with writing diary entries. Science will involve experiments investigating dissolving.
