Class Updates

FSU – FS1 have welcomed some new starters. Our older children are busy helping them settle in and make friends. Some children are staying for lunch, yum! FS2 have been thinking about their Easter holidays. One person went to a car boot sale and we set one up in our playground!

Year 1/2 - in Class 1 & 2 we are writing our own Little Red Riding Hood stories and working on our calculation skills in Maths. In Class 3 we are learning the names of 3D shapes and describing their properties. We have learnt all about the story of Little Red Riding Hood and are now writing our own version.

Year 3/4 – Year 3 and 4 will be starting their new topic of "Forces of Nature", which we are all very excited about. We will be applying our subtraction skills to solve problems. Year 4 will be continuing with their swimming lessons on Wednesdays.

Year 4/5 - The children in 4/5 will be designing a space rocket and using this as a basis for writing instructions as part of their topic and literacy learning this week. In Maths we are solving problems using formal written methods for addition and subtraction, using our rounding skills to estimate and check answers.

Year 5/6 & 6 – This week we are focusing on averages and translation in Maths, relative clauses and adverbials in writing. We will have a focus on all of the Y5/6 spellings this week in preparation for SATs. Cricket and dance will be taught during our PE lessons.
