Well done this week to Year 1 (Mrs Goss and Mrs Lodge's classes) with 13% more than last week!! Closely followed by Mr Price's class (Y3/4). We have been giving the children opportunities to log onto abacus in school as well, to support them with their mental maths!

Class Updates

FSU – This week our 'Spark' is insects, we are going on bug hunts around the FSU garden and using identification sheets to see what we have found. Can you find any insects in your garden at home?

Year 1 – We are going on a minibeast hunt and we will use what we find to help us add 'ing' correctly to the ends of words to describe what the creatures are doing. In Maths, we are grouping, sharing and learning to write division calculations.

Year 2 – We will be working with measures and fractions in Maths. We will continue to learn about rainforests and the children will be using this to write information.

Year 3/4 –This week in Year 3 and 4, we will be planning our historical story based on our class book. In maths, we will be finishing our work on time and then using our problem solving skills to investigate different aspect of Maths.

Year 4/5 – This week in year 4/5 we will be planning and starting to write out historical narrative. In Maths we are continuing to develop our understanding of how to use decimals in maths and will also be doing more problem solving in meta-cognition to assess our 'growth mindset' skills.

Year 5/6 & 6 - Next week, we will be starting our DT project planning, designing, making and evaluating our own Tudor Houses. Year 6 children are very excited about the Newcastle trip on Wednesday and rehearsing for the Tudor Rose performance. In maths, Year 5 children will be focussing on fractions and the properties of shapes.

We are very much looking forward to Box2BFit on Wednesday 28th June. We really enjoyed the skipping so we are sure this will be just as exciting!
